Holywell Primary School



Intelligent Energy's Charitable Trust first launched in January 2019 with the aim of making an impact on the local community it operates within. The Trust supports charitable and voluntary organisations, local to Intelligent Energy's headquarters in Loughborough, which support and aid amongst others; community groups, young people, sport and lifelong learning.

The Trust currently distributes £100,000 each year and several organisations have already benefited from funding awards, including Holywell Primary School who received £6,100 in 2024.

Holywell Primary School wanted to provide more outdoor learning opportunities for their students, however did not have the facilities to do so that weather proofed these activities.

Outdoor learning offers many benefits including improved physical and mental health. It also creates an environment for creativity and confidence building.

With the funding from Intelligent Energy's Charitable Trust, the School has been able to install a canopy outside their Year 1 classrooms to provide an enhanced learning environment. The children at Holywell School will now be able to access this outdoor space all year round as part of their learning, giving them shade in the summer and shelter from the elements in the winter.

They have already been outside making use of the canopy and it will be used daily to support their learning.
